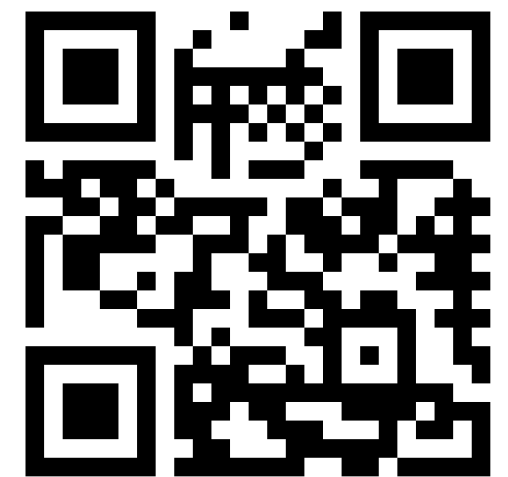

Our nationally certified Asthma Management Program helps children ages 18 and younger with an asthma diagnosis better manage their condition to experience symptom-free sleep, learning and play.

Our 3 – 6 month program focuses on asthma education and care coordination for your child and all the important caretakers in their life.

The program serves 7 counties including Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Kaufman, Rockwall, and Tarrant.

- Diagnosis of asthma
- Ages 18 yrs and under (if under 2 yrs of age, must be followed by a specialist)

- Participant is a member of a payor source (commercial, private, or government funded) and has a Health Care Provider (HCP)

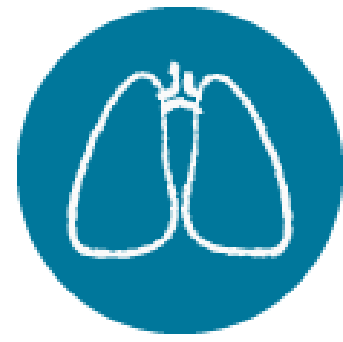

Services Provided

Asthma 411 is a comprehensive, evidence-based program in Tarrant County provided by a large group of healthcare partners. Asthma 411 provides resources for school nurses to help children who have trouble breathing. As part of the program, a school nurse can give a breathing treatment to a child who is struggling to breathe while at school.

Asthma 411 also provides learning tools for schools and families. These learning tools help children and families understand asthma better. When families understand asthma better, they can help their child feel more in control of breathing and improve asthma symptoms.
